- 3) 1 Essay no more than 2 pages in length, times new roman font (size 12), 1" margins, & double-spaced
- 4) Current high school transcript
- 5) A copy of a college/university, trade school or community college acceptance letter

Scoring:

The Prosperous Investments Scholarship Scoring Committee will evaluate each application and select ONE winner. If there is a tie, the prize money will be split. The winning essay will be scored based on the grading rubric (appendix A).

Winning Amount:

The Prosperous Investments Scholarship will award a minimum of \$1,500.00 to the winning applicant. Payment will be to the institution that the winner will attend in the fall.

Deadline:

Applications postmarked after 31 May 2024 will not be accepted and returned to sender. Prosperous Investments will announce the winner no later than 1 August 2024.
