- 3) 1 Essay no more than 2 pages in length, Times New Roman font (size 12), 1" margins, & double-spaced
- 4) Current high school transcript
- 5) A copy of a college/university, trade school, or community college acceptance letter

Scoring:

The Prosperous Investments Scholarship Scoring Committee will evaluate each application and select ONE winner. If there is a tie, the prize money will be split. Essays will be scored using the grading rubric (Appendix A).

Winning Amount:

The Prosperous Investments Scholarship will award the winning applicant a minimum of \$1,500.00. The payment will be made to the institution the winner will attend in the fall.

Deadline:

Applications received or postmarked after 31 May will not be accepted and will be returned to the sender. Prosperous Investments will announce the winner no later than 1 August 2024.
